



## Fall 2016 - Withdrawal Schedule

As of the first day of classes, students who wish to drop **ALL** courses for which they are registered must withdraw from the university to avoid academic or financial responsibility. Check the important links on the [Withdrawing from UNC Charlotte](#) website to be sure that you have completed all of the appropriate notifications.

Students awarded Federal financial aid will also be subject to the Return of Title IV Funds Policy. This may result in a balance due on your tuition and fees bill. Federal Title IV aid includes Stafford Loans, Perkins Loans, PLUS Loans, Pell Grants, SEOG Grants, ACG Grants, and SMART Grants. **Tuition and mandatory fee** reduction for Official Withdrawals are prorated based on the schedule below. Students who completely withdraw from the University by these dates are due a reduction of their tuition and fees as follows:

<b>Withdrawal</b>	<b>Date</b>	<b>Reduction %</b>
Through the end of add/drop	August 29	100%
Completion of 20% of term	August 30 – September 19	90%
Completion of 40% of term	September 20 – October 10	50%
Completion of 60% of term	October 11 – October 31	25%
No reduction	November 1	0%
